A modern soul

A detailed project uses materials, finishing touches and technical functionality to create new and evocative environments.

Fiddling with an independent villa – placed in a splendid hilly location – to make it the proper abode for your family is an operation both fascinating and “dangerous” at the same time. Several problems to deal with: only an attentive and precise project able to co-operate technical aspects with formal and stylistic ones can achieve the desired effect.

Turra Arredamenti's staff has been able to carry out and accomplish this work, by means of redefining all different environments and by researching finishing touches, furniture and lighting.

The result is a living area where a large open-space encloses the kitchen, the dining area and the living room, all marked by evocative scenery flats and defined by an ad-hoc composition, designed according to the owners' needs.

Living room and dining area are separated by a smoky-grey glass scenery flat with a see-through effect where a bio-ethanol fireplace system lies on; a large sofa offering extreme and individual comfort – crafted using thick leather in cocoa brown shades – converses with an original vintage carpet, a solid handmade stainless-steel small table and two metal-structured armchairs with leather body and cushions in woven fabric;

moreover, a wall-mounted TV stand with lacquered matte storage furniture and woodwork with a pop-up audio/video system.

For the lunch area, the elegant Xilos table by Maxalto matches Febo fabric armchairs and the “Flying Flames” chandelier, with an original system able to combine LED candles with simple and functional downlight elements. By means of a lowered scenery flat – with room for the kitchen storage elements –, we move to the kitchen, conceived with matte lacquered shutters, a countertop and a sink in Kerlite Materica; the peninsula houses an induction hob with integrated aspiration system and a snack area with metal stools upholstered in eco-friendly leather; the lighting is entrusted to Flos with adjustable lighting fixtures and under shelves with dimmable LED bulbs.

The same attention has been given to stylistic details, technical aspects but also to the sleeping area, bathrooms and outdoor spaces. The master bathroom is a perfect example: an elegant freestanding bathtub faces a large shower equipped with chromotherapy, together with freestanding charcoal-grey durmast furniture with a polished white Corian® thickness and integrated tanks.
